SEMINAR EURO 2012 FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS IN POLAND BRITISH SECURITY SOLUTIONS FOR MASS EVENTS

On 18 April 2007 Poland and Ukraine won the right to host the European Football Championships in 2012. 1. **Antiterrorist security systems for stadia and their surroundings including:**
 - a) **Integrated access control systems ;**
 - b) **Systems, equipment and installations for detection of explosives, radioactive materials, water and air pollution;**
 - c) **Non-invasive methods of clothing, luggage and vehicle control.**
2. **Integrated crowd control system.**
 - a) **Ticketing systems which are relatively cheap in production, multifunctional (access, parking, public city transport, small shopping within the stadium), safe (fraud proof);**
 - b) **Integrated database of tickets sold including:**
 - **system refusals (e.g. to people banned from access to mass events),**
 - **data on ticket holders (minimum: name, surname, personal id number as well as ID number),**
 - **ticket cancellation and validity data,**
 - **stadium access registration (section, time),**
 - **sector and section filling;**
3. **Audio-visual recording of crowd behaviour.**
 - a) **Monitoring systems design;**
 - b) **Audio and video material transfer, viewing and recording systems;**
 - c) **Monitoring management systems, including integration with access control.**
4. **Professional acoustic systems and visual information systems.**
5. **Training for stewards. Their tasks and competences. Division of tasks and responsibilities between stewards and public services (police etc).**

British expertise in providing security solutions at football stadia is recognised and highly respected in Poland. Poland has less than three years to make preparations for the championships and decisions will be made soon on specific 2012 security projects.
